Dear All,

Time is travelling fast, and at ITC-SA we have been overtaken by the pace of all the events happening around us. Yes, we are in month six and we have officially crossed over into the second half of 2014. We have also completed our first quarter for the 2014-2015 financial year. With this in mind, I need to confirm some of the outcomes reported at the ITC-SA Board Meeting which took place on the 29th of May 2014 and which reflects performance as at end of April 2014.

Operationally:

Statistical Information:

The current membership status of the ITC-SA is as follows:

• System Members:	4	(1 applications pending)
• Fabricator Members	213	(0 applications pending)
• Erector Members	45	(20 applications pending)
• Inspector Members	71	(0 Applications pending)
• Engineering Members	16	(9 Applications pending)
• Associate Members	5	(0 Applications pending)
• Honorary Members	5	(0 Applications pending)
• Fabricator Designer Members	21	(13 Applications pending)

Audit Inspections:

Nationally, 50 Audit Inspections have been done to date and the failure numbers of the first audit inspections have decreased significantly from last year. Most W/Cape fabricators are busy and have work for the next few months. Erector workload is improving. SATAS is busy, but have not submitted many reports to date.

Public Relations:

Nationally, the ITC-SA has dealt with 10 enquiries and complaints to date. During April, one complaint was resolved in W/Cape. Two complaints were investigated in E/Cape. One roof with site application plates was condemned, and the ITC-SA has received two complaints in regards to roof inspections. Investigations into alleged misconduct will commence soon.

Branch Meetings:

The branch meeting for Western Cape for April had to be moved to the 4th of June due to the unavailability of a number of key participants. The services of the Gauteng Regional Representative will be called upon to attend the Gauteng and KZN meetings and will be on occasion joined by the Executive Officer.

Marketing and Promotion:

During April, W/Cape had one visit to a Local Authority to discuss ITC-SA. A presentation was done to the third year students of Wood Technology at NMMU Saasveld Campus in George.

ITC Liaison:

W/Cape has had meetings with the NHBRC, ITFB and all the represented System Members.

Generally:

The ITC-SA has been active in all the Regions, and all operational targets will be attained by the end of this financial year.
